Before Starting the Installation

For this example, I created a folder or directory named "AVT_Term" in the root of the 'C:' drive.

Therefore, the path to that folder is: "C:\AVT_Term\".

1. Download the file:

AVT_Hex_Terminal_xx.zip from our web site. (xx = version number) Link to the page and section where to get that file: http://www.AVT-HQ.com/download.htm#Hex_Term_SW

- 2. Place the file into a folder of your choice.
- 3. Unzip and place all the files into that folder.

Remember:

Substitute the path for your installation into the listed commands; in place of the "C:\AVT_Term\".

Installation Instructions for Windows 7 (32 and 64 bit)

1. Open a command prompt window with 'Administrator' privileges.

Do this by going to: Start Menu | Programs | Accessories | Move your mouse over the 'Command Prompt' selection and right click. Select 'Administrator'.

- 2. In the Command Prompt window, move to the directory where you unzipped the Hex Terminal files. (use the CD command)
- Register three files using the commands listed.
 Remember to substitute the correct path of your installation.
- 4. regsvr32 C:\AVT_Term\TimerMM.dll
- 5. regsvr32 C:\AVT_Term\MSWINSCK.OCX
- 6. regsvr32 C:\AVT_Term\COMDLG32.OCX
- 7. You should receive a system notification that the file was successfully registered, for each file.
- 8. You're done.
- 9. Launch the 'Hex Terminal' application by double clicking on the executable: Hex_term_xx.exe

(where 'xx' is the version number)

10. You can also create a shortcut of the 'Hex Terminal' application and put it on your desktop or in your Start Menu.

Remove 'Hex Terminal'

To remove the 'Hex Terminal' you only need to un-register those files. Open a command window, with Administrator privileges, and enter these commands.

As before, be sure to substitute the correct path of your installation.

Note the "/u" in the command.

- 1. regsvr32 /u C:\AVT_Term\TimerMM.dll
- 2. regsvr32 /u C:\AVT_Term\MSWINSCK.OCX
- 3. regsvr32 /u C:\AVT_Term\COMDLG32.OCX

Then delete all the files, the folder, and any shortcuts you created.

Installation Instructions for Windows XP

 Open a command prompt window. Do this by:

Start Menu | Programs | Accessories | Command Prompt

- 2. In the Command Prompt window, move to the directory where you unzipped the Hex Terminal files. (use the CD command)
- 3. Register three files using the commands listed. Remember to substitute the correct path of your installation.
- 4. regsvr32 C:\AVT_Term\TimerMM.dll
- 5. regsvr32 C:\AVT_Term\MSWINSCK.OCX
- 6. regsvr32 C:\AVT_Term\COMDLG32.OCX
- 7. You should receive a system notification that the file was successfully registered, for each file.
- 8. You're done.
- 9. Launch the 'Hex Terminal' application by double clicking on the executable: Hex_term_xx.exe

(where 'xx' is the version number)

10. You can also create a shortcut of the 'Hex Terminal' application and put it on your desktop or in your Start Menu.

Remove 'Hex Terminal'

To remove the 'Hex Terminal' you only need to un-register those files. Open a command window and enter these commands.

As before, be sure to substitute the correct path of your installation.

Note the "/u" in the command.

- 1. regsvr32 /u C:\AVT_Term\TimerMM.dll
- 2. regsvr32 /u C:\AVT_Term\MSWINSCK.OCX
- 3. regsvr32 /u C:\AVT_Term\COMDLG32.OCX

Then delete all the files, the folder, and any shortcuts you created.
